



Pool Rules and Regulations

1. Lifeguards must be on duty and the pool officially opened before swimmers are allowed in the water. Life guards will enforce all pool rules and must be adhered to at all times
2. Members must sign in with the greeter and present their Crofton Country Club issued identification card.
3. Guests must be accompanied by a Member at all times. The Member must sign in the guest and be charged the appropriate guest fees. Rain checks are not available.
4. Members will be held accountable for the actions of their guests. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. Offenders will be asked to leave the facility and face possible revocation of membership without a refund.
5. Only food and beverage purchased from the Club are allowed in the pool area in accordance with Maryland state law. Members are asked to help clean up after themselves and their children.
6. Children with diapers or who are not COMPLETELY toilet trained are not permitted in the main pool. This includes swim diapers or rubber pants. Parents take full responsibility for adhering to this rule. If a non-toilet trained child creates an "accident" in the main pool, the parents may be subject to any and all costs incurred as a result of the closing of the pool for proper treatment of the water and cleaning.
7. The pool may be closed at times for mechanical failure, operational problems, inclement weather or home swim meets. The decision is at the sole discretion of the pool management for the safety of our members.
8. Only front facing dives/flips are permitted off the diving board. For safety, there is NO diving permitted outside of the diving well.
9. All swimmers must shower before entering the pool.
10. NO SMOKING is allowed in the pool area.
11. The club will not be responsible for the loss or damage of personal property. Members and guests using the pool, diving board, slide, playground equipment, and other Club facilities do so at their own risk.
12. Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult or a responsible person over the age of 18 authorized by the minor's parents in writing. If the child is in the main pool, the guardian must be in the immediate vicinity unless the child is a proven swimmer as determined by pool management. Members and guests of any age take full responsibility for their own safety.
13. A parent or guardian must closely watch children at all times while in the pool or in the facility. A parent or guardian must accompany non-swimmers in the water at all times. Swim tests will be given to anyone under the age of 14 or at the discretion of pool management.
14. For the purpose of supporting non-swimmers, inner tubes, water rings, and all other floatation devices are not permitted in the main pool at any time. For safety purposes, only a life vest approved by the U.S. Coast Guard is to be used. If a child uses such a life vest, a parent or guardian must accompany the child at all times.
15. NO GLASS of any type is allowed in the pool area or restrooms.
16. Members and guests in the pool area must be dressed in proper swimming attire. No cut-offs, thongs, gym shorts, nor extraordinarily revealing swim attire is permitted.
17. Adult swim is for those 18 years and older and will be scheduled on the hour for a duration of 15 minutes. Neither children nor infants are permitted in the pool at this time even in the care of an adult.
18. The baby pool is reserved for children 6 years old and younger. Children in the baby pool must be under the constant supervision of their parents or guardian. Lifeguards are not responsible for supervision of the baby pool. If inappropriate behavior is exhibited at any time, notify a lifeguard.
19. Persons with infectious disease, bandages, open wounds, sores, or under the influence of alcohol or drugs are not permitted in the pool.
20. No running, shoving, rough play, or actions deemed dangerous by the lifeguards will be tolerated in the pool, facilities or on the deck.
21. Starting blocks are to be used during swim team completion or practice only.
22. Swimmers are not permitted to hang on or play around the ladders or steps.
23. Only one person is allowed on the diving board or slide at a time. There will be no rough inappropriate behavior permitted. Parents are responsible for their child's ability to use the diving board and slide.
24. When a swimmer from either the diving board or slide surfaces, they must immediately swim to the nearest ladder and exit the diving well. Only at that time may another swimmer begin to ascend the ladder to use the board or slide.
25. Swimming is not allowed in the diving well unless the board and slide are closed and the lifeguard has opened the well for swimming.
26. Swimmers must be aware of swimmers in the lap lane and yield to them. Diving into the lap lane or other shallow areas of the pool is never permitted.
27. Any question in regard to the pool rules should be discussed with the Head Lifeguard or the General Manger of Crofton Country Club. All concerns should be submitted in writing.
